

Safety Snapshot Photo Competition

Terms & Conditions

1. Acceptance of terms

Entry into this competition constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions (Terms).

2. Eligibility – Entry limits

The competition is limited to **one (1) photo per permit holder** who holds a current recreational permit.

3. Use of photographs

By submitting a photograph, you grant **Kaingaroa Tipu Ltd** a perpetual, royalty-free, non-exclusive licence to use the photograph for any purpose, including (but not limited to) promotional material, publications, displays, and websites, without compensation or prior consultation with the photographer or any individuals depicted in the photograph. Photo credit will be provided where reasonably practicable.

4. Eligible entrants

The competition is open to all current recreational permit holders, excluding professional photographers, employees of Kaingaroa Tipu Ltd, and their immediate families.

5. Entry requirements

To enter the competition, entrants must submit:

- full name;
- current recreational permit number;
- a valid email address;
- a hunting or fishing photograph that demonstrates or relates to safety;
- the location where the photograph was taken; and
- a short caption describing the photograph.
(Eligible Entrant)

6. Location and timing of photos

All photographs must be taken within **Kaingaroa Forest or Rotoehu Forest** during the current hunting season.

7. Ownership and permissions

Photographs must be the original work and property of the **Eligible Entrant** and of reasonable quality. By submitting an entry, you warrant that all individuals depicted in the photograph have consented to their image being used in the competition and in accordance with these Terms, including clause 3.

8. Competition period and judging

The competition opens on the **first weekend in May 2026** and closes on the **last Sunday in September 2026 at 5:00 pm**. Three (3) winners will be selected and notified by **31 October 2026**.

9. Winner notification

Winners will be notified by phone or email. If a winner cannot be contacted within **fourteen (14) days** of selection, the prize will be forfeited and an alternative winner may be selected.

10. Prizes

The prizes consist of **three (3) \$100 Hamills Rotorua gift vouchers**.

11. Judging decisions

All decisions are made at the discretion of **Kaingaroa Tipu Ltd** and are final. No correspondence will be entered into.

12. Prize conditions

Prizes are not transferable, exchangeable, or redeemable for cash.

13. Prize delivery

Prizes will only be delivered within New Zealand. Delivery may take up to **30 days** from the prize draw. If a winner is a New Zealand citizen residing overseas at the time of the draw, a New Zealand delivery address must be provided.

14. Method of entry

15. Right to withdraw or amend
